Winnipeg Parking Authority – Office Administration Staff

Under the general direction of the Office Administrator the incumbent will provide direct customer services to the clients of the WPA. Service will be provided in person, by phone or by e-mail. General duties will include:

1. Deal with customers at the counter regarding payment of fines, selling of parking products, answering questions about parking issues in the city.
2. Answer questions about the reasons why a particular ticket was issued.

3. Deal with clients in a professional manner.
4. Balance revenue intake on a daily basis.
5. Reply to client inquires over the internet by responding in a timely manner to assigned questions sent to the Authority.

Qualifications:

1. Demonstrated computer skills using Microsoft Office. Incumbents must be familiar with the use of Outlook, Word and have some knowledge of Excel
2. Experience in cash handling, daily reconciliation of income receipts.
3. Experience in direct dealing with customers.

General:

Successful applicants must be capable of completing a one week field training course to provide them with the necessary experience to deal with customers on why a particular ticket was issued to them for parking violations.

Newfoundland Quarters

Hang on to any of the new Newfoundland quarters. If you have them, they may be worth much more than 25 cents. The Canadian Mint announced today that it is recalling all of the Newfoundland quarters that are part of its program featuring quarters from each province. "We are recalling all of the new Newfoundland quarters that were recently issued," Canadian Mint Deputy Minister Jack Shackelford said Monday. "This action is being taken after numerous reports that the new quarters will not work in parking meters, toll booths, vending machines, pay phones, or other coin-operated devices." The quarters were issued in the order in which the various provinces joined Confederation and have been a tremendous success among coin collectors worldwide. "The problem lies in the unique design of the Newfoundland quarter, which was created by a team of Newfoundlanders," Shackelford said. "Apparently, the duct tape holding the two dimes and the nickel together keeps jamming."
