Dispatcher/Site Monitor

There is a requirement for a new Evening Dispatcher/Site Monitor. Under the direction of the Senior Dispatcher, the Dispatcher/Site Monitor is responsible for the effective coordination of the Spare, Part-Time and Casual Commissionaires. The Dispatchers schedule and assign these resources to short term contracts and positions of a recurring nature that are not a permanent site. The Dispatchers are responsible for the accurate and timely production of the daily worksheets.

The ideal person for this position is able to respond accurately and in a timely fashion to constantly changing requirements. You will have good computer skills in Microsoft Office. If you feel that you have the ability and interest for this position, apply in writing to the Director of Operations. Include a resume and covering letter with your application. Applications will close, 12 May 2006. This position will commence with training starting 22 May 2005.
