### A) Full Time Instructor & B) Full Time Dispatcher

**A)** Under the direction of the Training Officer, the successful Instructor candidate(s) will be responsible for the presentation of security and related training in support of Division and Client requirements. The incumbent will be employed at our new facility at 83 Sherbrook St. The successful candidate must be willing to travel and conduct training at remote sites. Some evening and weekend work will be required. Experience in the development and presentation of military or civilian classroom and On Job Training will be an asset. Experience with the Division will be an asset. The candidate will undergo a 3 month probationary period before employment is confirmed.

**B)** Under the direction of the Senior Dispatcher, the successful Dispatch candidate(s) will be responsible for the effective coordination and management of the Spare, Part-time and Casual Commissionaires. The Dispatcher schedules and assigns Cmres to short-term contracts and positions of a recurring nature that are not a permanent work site.
