Those of you that travel Sherbrook Street just north of Misericordia medical center may have noticed a lot of "Commissionaire activity" in the vicinity of 83 Sherbrook.

Located on the second floor of the strip mall at that location will be our new Security Guard training center (the exact name has not yet been determined) under the watchful eye of Len Baspaly. We have found that the various Commissionaires courses for ourselves and with emerging new training opportunities on the horizon, we have outgrown our present training capacity at 50 Stafford.

To accommodate everyone, and allow us to develop training as a business stream of it's own, we needed to find a location that would allow us to focus on training without tying up the Division office spaces to do so; hence our decision to find additional space to call our own. While this facility will be primarily focused on training, that will not be its only focus.

If you are in that area after mid Jun, drop in a say hello and take a look around. The main entrance is in the middle of the building, go upstairs and follow the corridor straight ahead and to the left to find us.
